

# POOL RULE REMINDER

While fun is 100 percent encouraged, safety is also mandatory. We had a few issues over the last few weekends and want to remind everyone of the Pool Rules. ***Remember a violation of the Pool Rules can result in the loss of pool privileges.*** \*\*\*\*\* Please be advised due to recent issues the showers in the restrooms will no longer be available. Also, the pool noodles have been removed.

- Pool hours: **M:** 12 PM-10PM **Tues-Sun:** 10 AM-10PM
- **No alcohol** is allowed at any time.
- Please, no **suntan lotion or oils** in the swimming pool water. Of course, you should protect your skin, we simply encourage you to make sure your lotion is dry before you go in the water.
- No **smoking or vaping** in the pool area. Be courteous of the people around you and step outside the pool and playground area.
- Please keep **gates** closed in the pool area and do not open the gates for anyone without a pool key. They aren't allowed without being present with a Member/Occupant who should have a key. Also, please be aware whoever you allow access becomes your guest and responsibility.
- An adult must accompany anyone **under the age of 14**.
- **Diapers** are not allowed in the swimming pool. Please only use swim diapers that are made specifically for swimming.
- **No lifeguard** will be on duty. Persons using the pool facilities do so at their own risk. Management/Concord Village, Inc. assumes no responsibility for articles lost, stolen or damaged.
- Should there be any **malfunction** of the swimming pool. Please call the Emergency Maintenance immediately. 602-615-5493 (**Don't assume that somebody else already reported the malfunction**).
- Eating is only permitted under the ramadas. No drinks, candy, tobacco, popcorn, gum, alcohol, or food of any kind shall be permitted in the pool or within the required walkways of the pool. **Trash bins** are provided. Please help keep the pool area nice and clean.
- **No glass** of any kind is allowed in the pool area. This is to prevent any situations with broken glass that could result in injury to anyone.
- Running, jumping, "**horseplay**" fighting, boisterous or dangerous conduct is forbidden in or around the pool area.
- Please refrain from moving the umbrellas. Moving them incorrectly can cause damage to the base as well as the pavers. Umbrellas need to be lowered after use or when windy.
- All persons utilizing the pool area must wear proper swim attire. Infants and toddlers must have swimsuits covering their swim diapers and must be supervised by an adult. No cut-offs are allowed. No black sole shoes are allowed. No fully clothed persons are allowed in the pool.
- Safety equipment is to be used for safety purposes only. Members may not play with safety equipment.

***These rules are easy to follow and can be just as easy to break. Please be respectful of the rules to ensure that we can all enjoy a safe and fun pool experience!***
